Overview of the exam paper.

2 essay questions and translation.

Question 1 – Choose 1a or 1b, write 80-90 words in French, four bullet points – each one must be referred to, not necessarily in equal detail, include references to present tense, past tense and future tense.

Question 1: **CHOOSE** 1a **OR** 1b.

Write 80 – 90 words in French, respond to **EVERY** bullet point, use verbs in the present tense, a past tense and in a future tense, give opinions in each time frame.

Tips for question 1a or 1b

- ❖ Read the bullet points carefully
- ❖ Identify requirements; (opinion/preference/detail)
- ❖ Identify the tense (the second bullet point is always about a past event; the last bullet point is always in the future)
- ❖ **All** the bullet points must be covered (some might be more detailed than others)

A l'avenir ...	In the future

Write 130-150 words in French, respond to **EVERY** bullet point, use verbs in the present tense, a past tense and in a future tense, give opinions and justifications in each time frame.

- ❖ Read the bullet points carefully
- ❖ Identify requirements; (opinion/preference/detail)
- ❖ Identify the tense- present, past and future tense?
- ❖ **All** the bullet points must be covered (some might be more detailed than others)
- ❖ Include some "wow" phrases and "uncommon" language.

Question 3 Translation

Learning languages

3 Traduis le passage suivant **en français** :

I like French and Spanish, which I study at school. I often go to a village in Martinique where I talk to the people every day. Last year my family and I went to Switzerland for the first time. The experience of going abroad and learning about the culture of the country is interesting.

I often go (Often I go) = Souvent je vais

Where = ou

Last year = l'année dernière

...is interesting – c'est intéressant/ ...m'intéresse

Tips for Translation

- ❖ Read the **WHOLE** of each sentence;
- ❖ Underline or highlight what you can do instantly ;
- ❖ Think about word order in French;
- ❖ Translate by phrase - not by word; (where possible)
- ❖ Look at any gaps, can you think logically what needs /could go there?
- ❖ Points will be awarded for partial communication (any accurate words)
- ❖ Look for clues (Time markers) to identify the appropriate tense
- ❖ Think about tenses – check verb endings.
