- Underline or highlight what you can do instantly;
- Think about word order in French;
- Translate by phrase not by word; (where possible)
- Look at any gaps, can you think logically what needs /could go there?
- Points will be awarded for partial communication (any accurate words)
- Look for clues (Time markers) to identify the appropriate tense
