1. The MAD TSHIRTS - Elements of Music:

In your music lessons we will be exploring how music is created and performed by exploring the elements of music, this is done through the **MAD T SHIRTS** model.

Each letter of MAD T SHIRTS is a different element of Music.

Melody, Articulation, Dynamics, Texture, Structure, Harmony and Tonality, Instrumentation, Rhythm ad Tempo, Time and Metre and Style and Genre.

Research what each of these elements are and produce a poster informing people of the different elements. You could also include how they work together to create different sounds and effects? Create images to show the 'meaning' of each element as well as writing the element **IN BOLD** on the poster.

2. Music and Me

We would love to learn a little about you and your musical tastes, can you list three pieces of music that mean something to you and tell us the reason why?

It could be a song or piece that reminds you or something or someone - it could be a piece of music from your favourite film, or a song or piece that is in a different genre to what you would normally listen too but you love. Tell us the name of the song, the artist and why you like it.

3. Is Music All Around You?

Can you imagine a world without music? It would be pretty dull!

We would like you to choose a day where you make notes about all the music you hear around you, from the alarm going off and waking up, to the moment you get into bed that night. List what you can hear and where is it coming from?

Is it on the radio, played on your phone/tablet or devices, is it on a computer game, from a TV show or movie, from an advert, someone singing or whistling in the street, a neighbour playing music that you can also hear, someone practising an instrument, a band outside or on a band stand or birdsong outside when walking?
