

LISKEARD SCHOOL & COMMUNITY COLLEGE (LSCC) – CV19 OUTBREAK MANAGEMENT PLAN

GENERAL

1. CV19 remains a risk to the health & safety of the school population. While national restrictions have been relaxed (and in many cases removed), it is critical LSCC maintains an outbreak management plan should we notice, or be notified by NHS Test & Trace that we need to emplace additional mitigations to **PROTECT** the school population.
2. LSCC Outbreak Management Plan is a RAG coded series of escalation held at the Headteacher and Governing Board discretion that can rapidly be implemented according to the local and national CV19 threat levels.
3. *Revised on 17/09/2021 due to case prevalence in local area & reviewed whole school response thresholds by PHE*
