Welcome to 'The Challenge of a Lifetime'

Dear Parent/Carer

As a school we are extremely proud of the diversity in the curriculum that we offer students at Liskeard. After the success of Challenge Week last year, we are looking forward to running the Week again this year.

Challenge Week gives students in Years 7 -9 the opportunity to embark on a journey; this may be a journey to explore new places or a journey that explores hidden talents and skills. Above all, it is a chance to learn about themselves and how they learn. In short - a journey of self-discovery.

This is an exciting week, where the curriculum is enriched by providing students with activities that cannot normally take place in an average day. Year 10 work experience will take place in the same week, and therefore Year 10 students will not be participating in Challenge Week.

We are offering a range of activities, varying in cost, with some being a minimal contribution or free, which allows all students to participate. The cost of each activity is shown on each page along with the required deposit. Please note that deposits can only be paid on Parentpay and are non-refundable, so please make sure your son/daughter selects their activity carefully.

Please read through this booklet to learn more about the exciting opportunities. There is a handy hints and tips page and I would be grateful if you could read these before your son/daughter makes his/her final choice.

As a school we are aware that trips have increased in price. However we will do our utmost to keep costs down and if the opportunity arises refunds will be forthcoming at the end of the year.

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Before going online and paying for/reserving your place for an activity, please take a few moments to read these hints/tips:

- Talk to your friends to find out what activity they will be doing.
- Only pick an activity that you think you can do. It is not easy to change your choice after the deadline (30/04/25), so you may be disappointed.
- Talk to the activity leader if you have any questions.
- Some of the activities will fill up very quickly and so you need to book, on Parentpay, as soon as your Year group goes live (Identify two reserve activity choices just in case your first choice is unavailable).

'Go Live Dates' for each Year group.

Year 8 - 05th February 2025 (at 9am)
Year 7 - 10th February 25 (at 9am)

How do I reserve my place on an activity?

Ok, you've had a good chat with your friends, and you've read through this presentation/book with someone at home and you've found an exciting activity that you would like to do.

- Take note of your Year group's 'Go live time and date' (see box above).
- On the 'Go live date', access Parentpay, identify your chosen activity and pay your deposit (**please note deposits must be paid for and are non-refundable**).
- To be on the safe side, ensure you have a back-up choice.
- Please remember all deposits are non-refundable.

Then what happens?

Once you have paid for the deposit on Parentpay, you are on the activity .

What happens if the activity I want to do is full?

If your activity has no spaces it will say it's full, then you will need to select your next choice.

I've been allocated a place on my activity, I've paid my deposit, how do I pay the rest?

Refer to the payment details on your chosen activity's page. This shows the required instalment on the next pay-by date. Some activities involve the school having to make payments to the activity providers in advance. Your help in meeting the deadlines will ensure that we do not incur any extra charges for late payment.

Can I pay by cash?

No, all payments must be made using Parentpay.

In exceptional circumstances, is the balance refundable?

Each request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, but as a rule of thumb, in the majority of cases no refund can be given (from 30/04/25), unless for an insured reason, ie, hospitalisation/medical issues.

My son/daughter has CV19 and can't attend - can I get a refund?

Sadly not - insurance premiums for CV19 are such that running costs of this scale would prevent them taking place. For higher cost activities we would recommend sourcing individual travel insurance should you wish this risk to be covered.

What if I want to change my activity before the deadline?

Please speak to Mr Lemin and he will try to accommodate your change. However, you will lose your non-refundable deposit on your existing activity, unless your place is filled before the deadline date.

What if I want to change my activity after the deadline?

Please note there will not be any changes after the deadline.

What is the final date for payment?

All money must be paid by 30th April 2025

We'll be staying at school and getting up close with some animal related visitors! During the rest of the day, we'll be making an animal related souvenir to take away - and might have time for an animal related film!

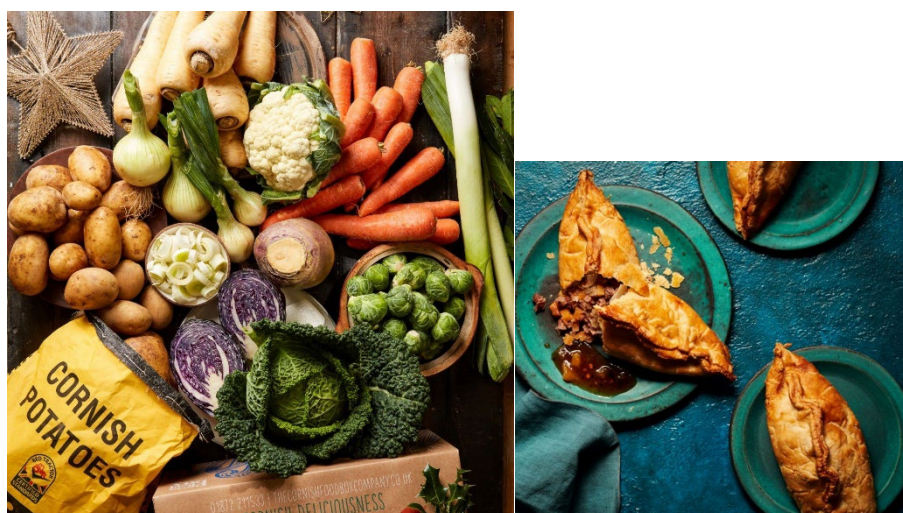
Friday – Newquay Zoo

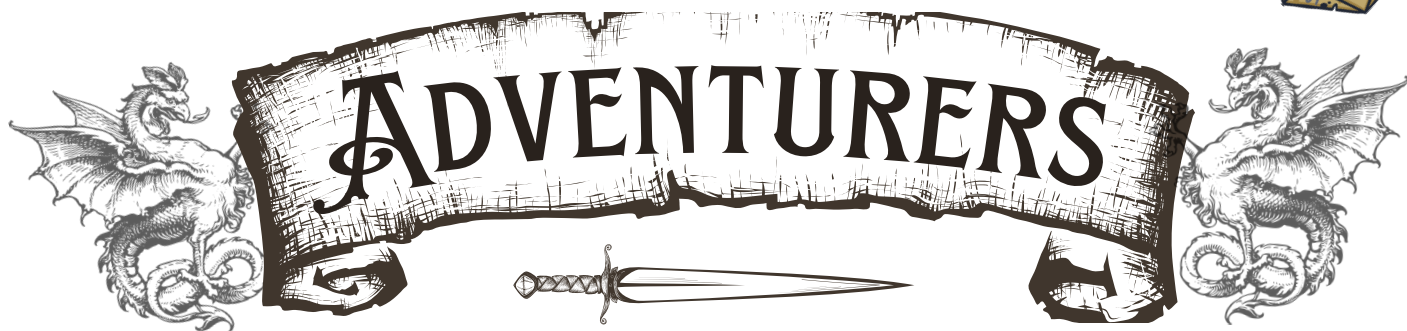

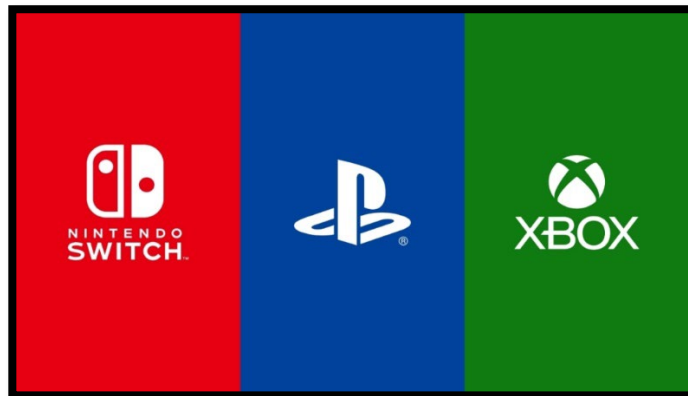

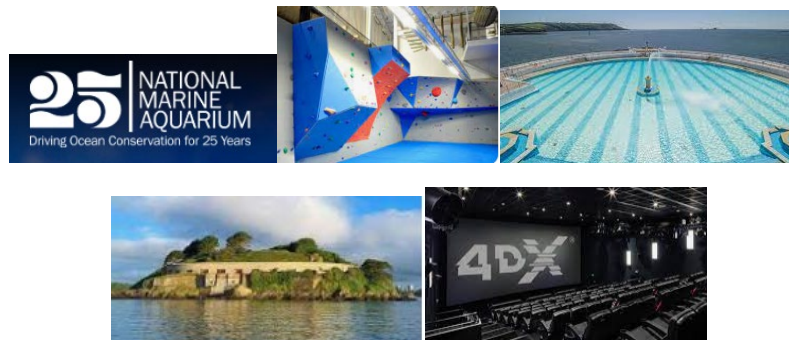

Explore the Fun Side of Plymouth

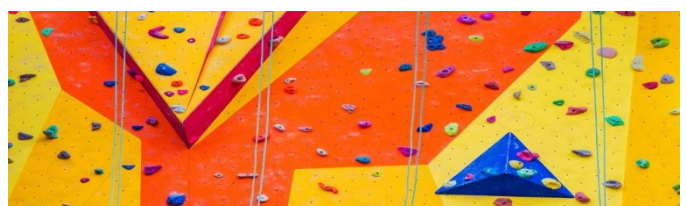


Mrs Ussher and Mrs Williams are looking for a group of students who want to experience the Fun Side of Plymouth.

Marine Biology Week

Have you considered becoming a marine biologist? Are you interested in marine life?



This challenge week, why not accompany Mr Baker and Mrs Wain (both qualified marine biologists) and see what it's all about?

We will spend a day rock-pooling to collect samples, before a second day using microscopy to identify species and look at patterns and shore ecology. We are then looking at spending one day fishing the reefs offshore to collect further samples to bring back to the lab. The following day we will identify and dissect the fish we have caught. Finally we will top it all off with a trip to the aquarium in Plymouth, where we can move around as a group and discuss some of the different species on show (some of which we may have already caught over the course of the week!).

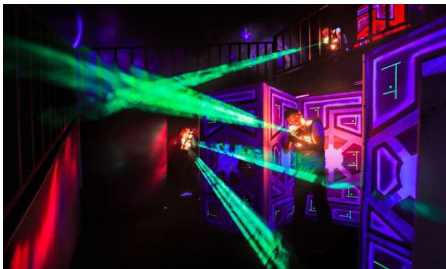


Operation Ager Artis!

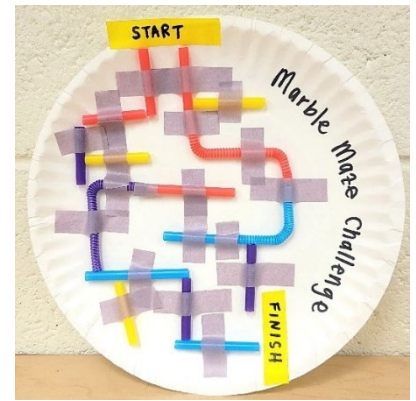

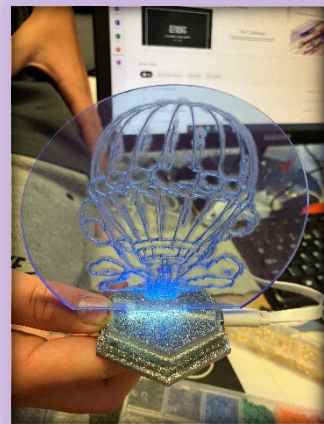
