# Before going online and paying for/reserving your place for an activity, please take a few moments to read these hints/tips:

- Talk to your friends to find out what activity they will be doing.
- Only pick an activity that you think you can do. Unfortunately, you cannot change your choice after the deadline (31/05/26), without an exceptional reason.
- Talk to the activity leader if you have any questions.
- Some of the activities will fill up very quickly and so you need to book, on Parentpay, as soon as your Year group goes live (Identify two reserve activity choices just in case your first choice is unavailable).

### How do I reserve my place on an activity?

Ok, you've had a good chat with your friends, and you've read through this presentation/book with someone at home and you've found an exciting activity that you would like to do.

- Take note of your Year group's 'Go live time and date' (see box above).
- On the 'Go live date', access Parentpay, identify your chosen activity and pay your deposit (**please note deposits must be paid to secure your place**).
- To be on the safe side, ensure you have a back-up choice.
- Please remember all deposits are non-refundable.

### Then what happens?

Once you have paid for the deposit on Parentpay, you are on the activity .

### What happens if the activity I want to do is full?

If your activity has no spaces it will say it's full, then you will need to select your next choice.

**I've been allocated a place on my activity, I've paid my deposit, how do I pay the rest?**

Refer to the payment details on your chosen activity's page. This shows the required instalment on the deadline dates. Some activities involve the school having to make payments to the activity providers in advance. Your help in meeting the deadlines will ensure that we do not incur any extra charges for late payment.

**Can I pay by cash?**

No, all payments must be made using Parentpay.

**In exceptional circumstances, is the balance refundable?**

Each request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, but as a rule of thumb, in the majority of cases no refund can be given (from 31/05/26), unless for an insured reason, ie, hospitalisation/medical issues.

**What if I want to change my activity before the deadline?**

Please speak to Mr Lemin and he will try to accommodate your change. However, you will lose your non-refundable deposit on your existing activity, unless your place is filled before the deadline date.

**What if I want to change my activity after the deadline?**

Please note there will not be any changes after the deadline.

**What is the final date for payment?**

All money must be paid by 31<sup>st</sup> May 2026

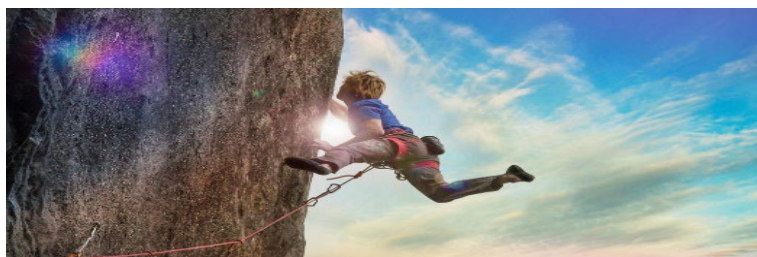

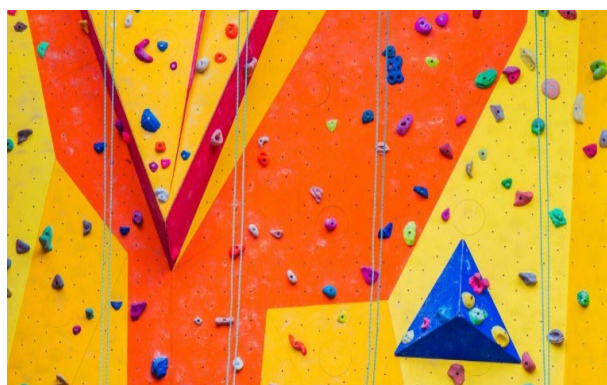


Mr Wilton is looking for a group of students who want to spend a week getting active in the outdoors.

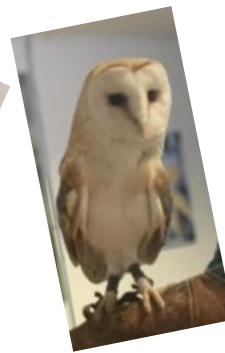
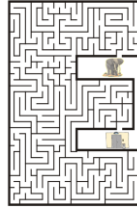
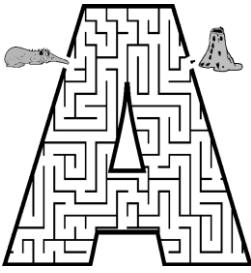

If you have answered 'YES' to any of these questions – then ANIMAL WEEK is for you! During the whole week, we will be visiting a range of places – to ensure we see everyone's favourite!

These visits are specifically organised to access a wide range of activities to have fun while learning for ALL students. Cornwall is especially diverse in range of habitats so we are very lucky to see many different genres in this exciting week!

### **Monday – Buckfast Butterflies and Dartmoor Otter Sanctuary**

We will be travelling by bus to the Sanctuary to visit their hothouse, where they breed and house exotic butterfly species and where you can see the terrapins. Outside, you will be able to see otters swimming and being fed. A member of the team will explain about life cycles, habitats and animal conservation during our visit.

### **Friday – Newquay Zoo**

By the end of the week, you will have decorated your very own keepsake box and will have filled it with handmade crafts that could be given as gifts or taken home for you to enjoy.

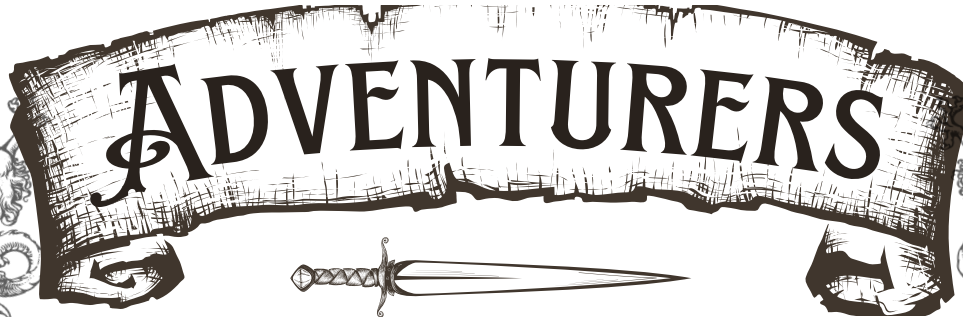

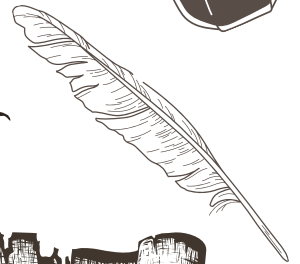

# Explore the Fun Side of Plymouth

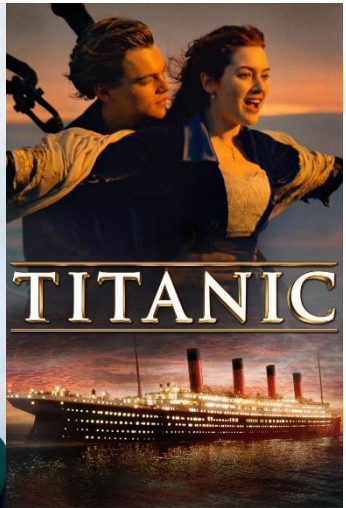


Mrs Ussher is looking for a group of students who want to experience the Fun Side of Plymouth.

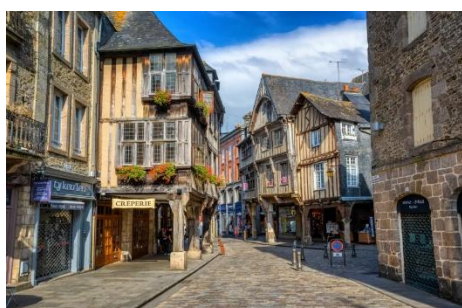

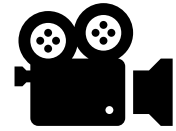
# Lost and Found

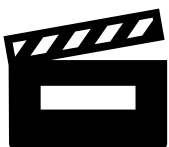

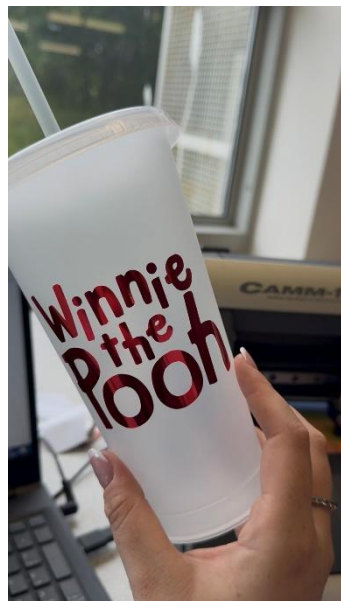
